SUBJECT: FY 2010, 1,095 Active Duty Operational Support (ADOS) Accounting Process

As a result of my 7 September 2010 memo, same subject, the actual notification to disapprove MAJCOM requests may not have been timely enough to allow some members sufficient transition time to inactive duty. Therefore, an extension of the tour end date to 22 October 2010 is approved for members that require additional transition time. For those members requiring up to a 60-day transition, please provide justification to AF/A1M NLT 1 October 2010. Justification should address undue hardship to the member.

Additionally, an extension of the tour end date to 22 October 2010 is approved for members whose previously submitted waivers were denied, and you are requesting reconsideration. The request for reconsideration to AF/A1M NLT 1 October 2010 must include a mission impact statement and specifically address why a particular individual is key to mission success.

By 8 October 2010 we will notify your MPA Man-Day Office managers which ARC volunteers are approved or disapproved to continue on active duty beyond 22 October 2010 for an additional 30 days for transition, as well as decisions on reconsideration.
