SUBJECT: NEW LEAVE BALANCE POLICY

This message is an update to the ARCNet message, *AFRC Commander's Call Topics and New Leave Policy*, December 2011.

As of September 30, 2011, new congressional law allows reservists, who are on orders for 30 days or more, to carry over their unused leave.

The previous policy required the member to sell any unused leave at the end of each tour.

Currently, Air Force Reserve officials are finalizing an implementation policy that will afford members to carry leave forward and expect the benefit to become fairly automatic soon. Additionally, pay systems will continue to maintain a record of all unused leave.

In the meantime, we ask you to maintain copies of your AF Form 988s to ensure your unused leave is captured correctly in the pay systems.

We are committed to ensuring you receive all benefits as a result of your dedicated service and will inform you once the policy has been implemented.
